



# SAA BURSARY

## ／ REPAYABLE AWARD PROGRAM

### THE SAA

**Bursary/Repayable Award Program assists graduates from accredited programs to launch their careers in the Province of Saskatchewan. It is funded by all SAA registered members.**

**The objective of the SAA Bursary/Repayable Award Program is to increase the number of architects practicing in Saskatchewan. This program is designed for students graduating from, or in their final year of, a CACB accredited architectural degree program who choose to locate to Saskatchewan following graduation. The program offers a repayable award of \$10,000CAD for up to three final-year students.**

## THE PROGRAM

The number of awards granted may vary at the SAA's discretion. Students at all accredited Canadian schools are eligible; those from other accredited North American schools may also apply but will be required to obtain a CACB Certificate and present their career plans.

Repayment forgiveness of the Bursary/Repayable Award is contingent on the completion of a three-year internship supervised by an SAA Member at an SAA licensed firm.

If the student changes plans and leaves either the profession or Saskatchewan, repayment of the remaining principal would be due two months after leaving the program. Late payment would incur interest at the current bank prime rate plus 2%.

The SAA will also consider award of the program to a student who plans to travel or work internationally for up to one year after graduation before settling in Saskatchewan. The forgiveness schedule in this case will commence when the candidate moves to Saskatchewan.

The SAA will have sole discretion in the award to any candidate based on the SAA's perception of the candidate's potential to establish a career in Saskatchewan. Included in the SAA's selection criteria will be the significance of the award in influencing the candidate's decision to move to Saskatchewan.

Selection of candidates for the program will be by an appointed committee under the authority of the SAA Council. The successful applicant will enter into a legal contract with the SAA that will detail the obligations of the applicant and the SAA to each other before the award is made.

The award will commit the SAA to provide the funds upon receipt of documentation confirming successful completion of the applicant's master's degree, a copy of the applicant's CACB Certificate, and a bona fide offer of employment from a Saskatchewan architectural firm.

The SAA retains the right to limit the number of awards if suitable candidates do not apply, at the sole discretion and judgment of the SAA. All other factors being equal, the SAA will give preference to those applicants who have backgrounds in Saskatchewan.

It will be incumbent on the student to secure employment with an architectural firm in the province. The SAA does not offer or guarantee that employment will be offered by any of the firms or practitioners in Saskatchewan.
