*Students in the Syllabus Program are alerted to the fact that beginning July 1, 2012, only architectural experience gained while actively enrolled in the Syllabus Program and registered as an SAA Syllabus Student Member will be eligible for credit in Saskatchewan. Student Associates in the Architecture Canada RAIC Syllabus Program may accumulate all of the required 3720 hours for experience gained after enrollment in Part II of the Syllabus. Students must be actively enrolled in the Syllabus Program while experience is being gained and must submit their Canadian Experience Record Book (CERB) to the SAA as per the experience submission requirements (refer to 3.0). An annual CERB review fee of \$100 will be assessed at the time of the first CERB submission, and then paid annually to the SAA by the 1st day of February.

The Bylaws of the SAA require that the applicant in the syllabus of studies programme is to be employed by a person(s) approved by the council for a period of ten (10) years or at the discretion of council based on the applicant's experience or the equivalent thereof. Please see Bylaw 10.04.
