OPEN Design Collaborative in Partnership with Remai Modern to Show *Integral Man*

OPEN Design Collaborative is partnering with Remai Modern to show *Integral Man*. The film tells the story of Jim Stewart and his home, Integral House, designed by Shim-Sutcliffe Architects.

Jim Stewart is the most published mathematician since Euclid, a concert level violinist, calculus professor, philanthropist, and gay rights activist. He is a true polymath, a modern day renaissance man. He had a bold vision and the conviction to follow through. It took almost ten years to realize his dream, Integral House, which was completed in 2009. Designed around a stunning internal concert hall, it was hailed as a masterpiece by some of the greatest architecture and design critics in the world. Integral House, like Jim, was unlike anything else. Now confronting his inability to play violin as arthritis cripples his hands, Jim boldly faces his declining health, jumping head long into the role of impresario. But it would not be so simple. As unexpected events unfold, Jim is left to make some of the most difficult decisions of his life.

SAA Bylaw Update

The SAA recently received notification from Minister Tell at the Ministry of Central Services that our regulatory bylaw amendments, passed by membership at the 2017 AGM, have been approved. An updated version of the SAA Bylaws can be found on the <u>SAA website</u>.

Bylaw 21 and the Annual CPI Increase

In accordance with Bylaw 21.01, SAA members are to be notified of the annual adjustment applied to suggested hourly fees. The increase has been indexed to the Government of Saskatchewan, Bureau of Statistics Ministry of Finance's Consumer Price Index (CPI) change. For January 2017/January 2016 the CPI increase is 1.6%. Table 'A' of the "SAA Professional Fees 2017 (Bylaw 21)" document specifies the SAA suggested hourly billing rates.

Construction Specifications Canada (CSC) Tour: International Trade Centre at Evraz Place

Join the CSC Regina Chapter for a tour of the International Trade Centre at Evraz Place —a 150,000 sq. ft. multi-purpose facility that joins all buildings on the 100-acre property, with the exception of Mosaic Stadium. When the facility opened in November 2017, it made Evraz Place one of the largest interconnected event complexes in North America. The International Trade Centre is the perfect location for trade and consumer shows, large meetings, catered events and everything in between.

The International Trade Centre has three multi-purpose spaces with multiple overhead doors for ease of movement. Two of the spaces are 22,000 sq. ft. and a third larger space is 46,000 sq. ft. The one-storey building also has a mezzanine area that overlooks the multi-purpose spaces.
